Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Hope you had a great long weekend. We have had some great attendance over the past few weeks. Quite often it has been at 100%. Thanks for your support here. Big thanks to the RSAS team for all their support and great food.

It was very sad what happened last weekend at the school. It was very unfortunate to have to keep the children away from school as it was unsafe for them to enter. We are still awaiting windows to be replaced in the middle primary class. We are hoping that they will be back in their normal class next week. Thank you for your patience. Could you please all endeavour to keep children off school grounds and report to us any trespassing. It has taken a lot to clean up and we have more work to do as we have calculated that it is over \$30,000 in damages, repairs, cleaning and replacement of school property. I want to make it very clear that criminal acts on school grounds will be reported to police. We have rescheduled the Wirangu beach day to later in the term.

It has been great to see the fantastic learning and behaviour in the junior primary class. All students are trying hard with their learning, sharing, talking nicely to each other and helping each other. These students are showing the other classes how to be great learners. Keep up the great work kids.

Today I have had the attendance officers at school looking at the school's data. Please ensure that if your child is ill or away for family purposes, that you complete an absence form at the front office. Notes of explained absences ensure your child(ren) are still eligible for the 100% attendance awards.

We are still noticing tired children. As I stated last week we will be sending these children home that are tired. They are unable to learn and cause behavioural problems in class. Please make sure your children are getting at least 9-10 hours sleep a night.

Lots coming up over the next couple of weeks with Easter long weekend and a couple of excursions for students. We will be letting you know when these are happening.
