Firstly, a big thanks to the parents/ guardians who attended the Learning Environment Opportunity Study (LEOS) consultation last Wednesday afternoon. This session was followed by student and staff consultations. Peter and Emma were wrapped with the conversations they had and the willingness of people to share their ideas. We are now waiting for their report and feedback.

School attendance continues to be a focus for our school moving forward. Football and Netball Grand Finals were held a fortnight ago. Our attendance dipped on both Friday the day prior and the Monday two days after. In discussions with many but not all families in 2023, families indicated that students should be at school on the Monday following grand final. We will continue to have school on the Monday following the local football and netball grand final again in 2025.
